### Islander InterNationals

**August 24, 25, 2013**

**1. Rules:** This regatta is to be governed by the 2013-2016 *Racing Rules of Sailing*, the prescriptions of US Sailing, and the rules of Islander 36 Association, except as any of these are changed by the Notice of Race or Sailing Instructions. The race is designated Category A.

#### **2. Eligibility:**

**Entry is open to all Islander Yachts.**

**Three divisions are planned: Spinnaker, non-Spinnaker and “Cruising”**

**2.1** All Islanders with a valid 2013 NC-PHRF rating certificate are permitted and encouraged to enter. "Non-certified boats will be assigned a standard Islander rating unless there are specific reasons to assign a different rating." .

**2.2** Competing boats will be encouraged to fly an Islander burgee while racing.

#### **3. Registration:**

**3.1** Registration and payment to be made in advance via PayPal at the Islander 36 web site; instructions for payment shall be found on the Islander 36 web site, [www.islander36.org/internationals13details.html](http://www.islander36.org/internationals13details.html).

**3.2** The entry form will be available on the Islander 36 Home Page, [www.islander36.org](http://www.islander36.org). click on the link to the event, and must be completed by Monday August 19. First Warning Signal at 11:55. Two races are planned.

Warning Signal at 10:55. A single race is planned

## **5. Racing Areas:**

### **5.1 Saturday, August 24:**

The intended racing area is the Knox/Yellow Bluff area of SF Bay using temporary and fixed mark courses published with the sailing instructions

### **5.2 Sunday August 25:**

It is intended the race start in the Knox area and use government/YRA marks to comprise a "Bay Tour".

**6. Sailing Instructions:** Will be available on the Islander 36 web page, <http://www.islander36.org> no later than Wednesday, August 21. Addendum, if applicable, will be posted no later than 5:00 pm on Friday, August 23.

**7. Scoring:** The low point scoring system.

**10. Docking:** Very Limited short term tie up is available during the day at the Sausalito Yacht Club dock. Several overnight moorings at SYC are available with dingy tie up possible nearby. Guest slips may be available independently with Sausalito Yacht Harbor and/or Clipper Yacht Harbor - contact them for reservation. You can sign up for an SYC mooring on the Race Entry Form.
